a/ Chairman . Cllr M. Simpson nominated Cllr G. Longbottom, seconded by Cllr D. Hunt. Cllr Longbottom elected as Chairman of Wressle Parish Council and signed Acceptance of Office.

b/ Vice Chairman. Cllr Longbottom nominated Cllr Gilpin. Seconded by Cllr Simpson. Cllr Gilpin was elected as Vice Chairman.

64/10 Matters arising

1/ Wressle Train Station. Emailed on the 8th February 2012 requesting documents under the Freedom of Information Act. Northern Rail have replied saying they are not bound by the Freedom of information Act therefore will not be supplying the documents requested. However they have raised the issues with the station manager who will be in touch regards the station in the future.

Councillors discussed having the Station listed as a Listed Building in order to protect it. Clerk to enquire about the process.

2/ Howden Pharmacy. This matter is now being pursued by Ward Councillor Paul Robinson and his Neighbourhood Action Committee. Cllr Robinson explained that he had spoken to Howden Town Council and that they had the same complaint's and concerns regarding the Pharmacy. He has now taken it to the Community Partnership Committee and the hands of the Health Representative of the committee. He promised to keep the Parish Council informed of the progress being made. Chairman thanked Cllr Robinson for his support.

3/ Meeting with Paul Robinson Highways regards Wellfield Bungalow. Been passed on to Rob Brown who is contactable on 01482 375753 / 0845 600 1666. Cllr David Hunt agreed to meet with the Clerk and Mr Brown.

4/ Road Edge at Fleet Dyke.

Parish Councillors were very unhappy with the response from the ERYC Highways Dept.. Councillors stated that although records might show that no accidents have been reported this does not mean they don't happen. Maybe they should talk to local landowner and ask how many vehicles he pulls out each year. They should listen to local knowledge and not statistics. As English Nature would not be happy with the dyke being filled in as it has an SSSI on it.

Cllr Simpson said that there was the added danger of that if someone came off here when the river was in flood then if trapped they could drown.

Clerk said that Bubwith Parish Council who share the same boundary as Wressle have also received complaints about this section and are also pursuing this matter. Clerk to write back to Highways.

Clerk to explore the possibility of having the work done in the interest of safety. Maybe the Community Grant could be used towards this. If not for this then look at the possibility of using it towards a VAS sign in the village.
